


# Invaders and Settlers

The currency of Mexico is the Mexican Peso.


**Jane Goodall:** a British scientist who has studied chimpanzees for many years.

**Qur'an:** a holy book written in the Arabic language that Muslims believe to be the actual words of Allah.


## Key Dates

AD 410: The last Romans leave Britain.



AD449: Saxons and Angles arrive in south east Britain.

## Five Pillars of Islam

**Shahadah:** sincerely reciting the Muslim profession of faith.

**Salat:** performing ritual prayers in the proper way five times each day.

**Zakat:** paying an alms (or charity) tax to benefit the poor and the needy.

**Sawm:** fasting during the month of Ramadan.

**Hajj:** pilgrimage to Mecca.
